

## HIGHLAND POLICE COMMISSION MEETING

May 11, 2017

The Highland Police Commission met in regular session at the Public Safety Building. Commissioner Jurczak called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Commissioner Jurczak, Krooswyk, Moes, Slagle and Danko were present as well as Chief Hojnicky, Attorney Rhett Tauber, and Town Council Member Konnie Kuiper.

Minutes of the April 13, 2017 meeting were approved.  
Approval was given to forward claims to the Town Council for payment.

### Personnel

On a motion by Commissioner Slagle and seconded by Commissioner Krooswyk, the Commission on a single roll call vote denied Commander Georgeff's request for the five (5) days of unpaid leave prior to his retirement. On another motion by Commissioner Slagle and seconded by Commissioner Krooswyk and the Commission voting to accept the retirement of Commander Georgeff to be effective June 7, 2017.

### Training

On a motion by Commissioner Moes and seconded by Commissioner Slagle the Commission on a viva voce vote approved the following training:

National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS); June 13-14, 2017; Danville, IN; IT- Jerry Koedyker; Registration- NA; Lodging- \$273.70 (2 nights @ \$119 plus tax); Per Diem- \$120 (\$60 per day max); Mileage- NA Dept vehicle.

### Accident Review

On a motion by Commissioner Krooswyk and seconded by Commissioner Moes the Commission on a viva voce vote concurred with the Accident Review Board and Administration, for the accident of Officer Jason Hildenbrand of April 8 2017, assessed as a No Fault No Penalty accident.

### SOP

On a motion by Commissioner Danko and seconded by Commissioner Slagle the Commission on a viva voce vote approved the amendment of SOP # 2.12- Pursuit.

### Promotion

On a motion by Commissioner Krooswyk and seconded by Commissioner Moes the Commission on a viva voce vote approved the promotion of Gerardo Garza Jr. to be promoted to 2<sup>nd</sup> Class as per SOP #1.1-Q to be effective June 4, 2017.

On a motion by Commissioner Moes and seconded by Commissioner Danko the Commission on a viva voce vote approved the list of Non permanent records to be destroyed as per State Form 44905.
