

June 8, 2017

The Highland Police Commission met in regular session at the Public Safety Building. Commissioner Jurczak called the meeting to order at 7:01 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Commissioner Jurczak, Krooswyk, Moes, Slagle and Danko were present as well as Chief Hojnicky, Attorney Jared Tauber, and Town Council Member Konnie Kuiper.

Minutes of the May 11, 2017 meeting were approved.
Approval was given to forward claims to the Town Council for payment.

Accident Review

On a motion by Commissioner Krooswyk and seconded by Commissioner Slagle the Commission on a viva voce vote concurred with the Accident Review Board and Administration, for the accident of Officer Nicholas Vanni of May 2 2017, assessed as an At Fault - possible Penalty assessed accident.

Hiring

On a motion by Commissioner Moes and seconded by Commissioner Slagle the Commission on a viva voce vote approved the hiring of Police Applicant Joel Sullivan as a 4th Class Probationary Patrolman to be effective July 30, 2017.

Promotion

On a motion by Commissioner Krooswyk and seconded by Commissioner Moes the Commission on a viva voce vote approved the promotion of Andrew Germonprez promoted to 1st Class as per SOP #1.1-Q to be effective July 16, 2017; and also the promotion of Deputy Commander John Banasiak to Commander to be effective June 18, 2017 as per SOP # 1.9.
