

HIGHLAND POLICE COMMISSION MEETING

August 9, 2018

The Highland Police Commission met in regular session at the Public Safety Building. Commissioner Moes called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Commissioners Jurczak, Slagle and Moes were present as well as Chief Hojnicky, Attorney Rhett Tauber and Town Councilman Herak, Police Commission Liaison. Absent with prior notice was Commissioner Danko and Commissioner Krooswyk.

Minutes of the July 12, 2018 meeting were approved.
Approval was given to forward claims to the Town Council for payment.

Accident Review

On a motion by Commissioner Jurczak and seconded by Commissioner Slagle the Commission on a viva voce vote approved the Accident Review Board and Administrations findings in the accidents of Corporal Erich Swisher of June 25th and Commander Ralph Podesta's of July 10th.

Hiring

On a motion by Commissioner Jurczak and seconded by Commissioner Slagle the Commission on a viva voce vote approved the hiring of Melanie Pabon, as a part time support services clerk pending a drug and polygraph test, to be effective 8-12-18 at an hourly rate of \$15.04.

Promotion

On a motion from Commissioner Slagle and seconded by Commissioner Jurczak the Commission on a viva voce vote approved the promotion of Patrolman Luke Paprocki to 3rd Class, to be effective 8-26-18.

Salary Ordinance

On a motion by Commissioner Jurczak and seconded by Commissioner Slagle the Commission on a viva voce vote approved the salary change requests regarding Specialty Pay.
