Those in attendance reviewed the petition request for S.J. Highland, LLC of Russell Construction & Real Estate Development for the proposed Rezoning from R1A to R3PUD & Subdivision for a proposed Senior Living Facility North of Stracks. Mr. Mika stated that a letter was received from Attorney Wieser on behalf of his client asking the Plan Commission for a continuance to the September meeting due to their engineering not being complete. Mr. Mika also stated that nothing has been submitted to us yet for review. The letter will be read and voted on at the Public Meeting.
