

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING AN
ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION OF THE SANITARY DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF
HIGHLAND**

The residents and taxpayers of the Sanitary District of the Town of Highland, Indiana (the “District”), are hereby notified that the Board of Sanitary Commissioners of the District (the “Board”) will hold a public hearing at 6:30 p.m. local time, on Tuesday, October 6, 2026, at the Highland Public Works Facility, located at 8001 Kennedy Avenue, Highland, Indiana, on the matter of appropriating the proceeds of the Town of Highland, Indiana, Sanitary District Bonds, Series 2026 (the “Bonds”), to be issued in an amount not to exceed \$30,000,000. The proceeds of the Bonds will be used to pay the cost of various sanitary district sewage works improvements in the District, including, without limitation, design and construction of a new North Fifth Street Lift Station and appurtenances and facilities pertaining thereto as part of the District’s compliance with a federal Consent Decree (including providing funds to the Hammond Sanitary District for the cost of sanitary district sewer improvements that serve the Highland Sanitary District) and all costs related thereto, including expenses in connection with or on account of the issuance of the Bonds.

The Bonds shall have a final maturity of no later than twenty (20) years after their issuance. The Bonds are payable from an ad valorem property tax to be levied on all taxable property in the District.

Said appropriation is in addition to any appropriations provided for in the existing budget and tax levy. At said public hearing, all persons shall have the right to appear and be heard on the necessity of said appropriation.
