

**NOTICE OF HEARING ON A DECLARATORY RESOLUTION BY
THE BOARD OF SANITARY COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND,
INDIANA**

Notice is hereby given that on September 1, 2026, the Board of Sanitary Commissioners of the Town of Highland, Indiana (the “Board”), being the governing body of the Sanitary District of the Town of Highland, Indiana (the “Sanitary District”), adopted a Declaratory Resolution, declaring that it will be necessary for the public health and welfare and will be of public utility and benefit to proceed with various sanitary district sewage works improvements in the District including, without limitation, design and construction of a new North Fifth Street Lift Station and appurtenances and facilities pertaining thereto as part of the District’s compliance with a federal Consent Decree (including providing funds to the Hammond Sanitary District for the cost of sanitary district sewer improvements that serve the Highland Sanitary District) and all costs related thereto, including expenses in connection with or on account of the issuance of the Bonds (collectively, the “Project”).

Notice is further given that said Declaratory Resolution and the general plans, together with cost estimates thereof, are on file and available for public inspection at the Highland Public Works Facility, located at 8001 Kennedy Avenue, Highland, Indiana.

Notice is further given that the Board shall hold a public hearing on Tuesday, October 6, 2026 at 6:30 p.m. at the Highland Public Works Facility, located at 8001 Kennedy Avenue, Highland, Indiana, to receive and hear remonstrances from persons interested in or who will be affected by these proceedings, and the Board will then take final action determining the public utility and benefit of the proposed Project and shall confirm, modify and confirm as modified or rescind the Declaratory Resolution.
